

Health Center Protocol

- 2 RN's on camp at all times
 - Only 1 off camp at a time.
 - RN OD was bring kid to office, call for 1st aid came in and kid twisted ankle simultaneously
- Only 1 RN to deliver missed Meds.
- Health Center is NOT a "hang out" spot
 - If not OD please don't "hang out" in Health Center
 - Small space
 - Distracts from work/focus
 - Not a place for your kids to visit or hang out
 - NO off camp food for ANY campers
 - Including your kids
 - Infirmary beds are for sick campers/staff ONLY
- If a call comes for RN On Duty
 - Answer ASAP
 - Go to location ASAP
 - Ø "is it an emergency"...assume it is.
 - Counselors are not trained to make that call
- RN who cares for a camper/staff MUST be the one to do ALL charting and should not leave till charting for that case is complete...even if official shift end time has come.
- We expect our RN's to be hands-on care givers.
 - Jeremy & kid with cut ear:
 - Ø give the kid a swab and say "here you go clean that off".
 - Ø point to throat coat and say "there it is help yourself".
 - You are here to TAKE CARE of the campers AND staff...not show them where the supplies are so they can treat themselves.
- ALL nurses are expected to stay until 2PM on the final Sunday in order to COMPLETELY close out session before they leave.
